Spanning approximately 3,500 square feet over five levels, this remarkable residence blends the charm and character of ancient architecture with the practicality and comfort of modern living.

DESCRIPTION

Cramond Tower offers a once-in-a-generation opportunity to own a landmark property steeped in heritage. Set discreetly back from the road, this former defensive tower now serves as a warm and inviting home, retaining countless period details while offering the space and facilities required for contemporary family life.

The tower element provides an atmospheric and beautifully preserved historic core, with stone spiral staircases, thick walls, and elevated views, while the later extension creates generous living spaces filled with natural light. The result is a home of remarkable character, combining authenticity with functionality.

Outside, the property enjoys extensive private parking and a secluded setting that feels almost rural - yet with all the convenience of urban living. Located just a short walk from the banks of the River Almond and the picturesque Cramond waterfront, the Tower also benefits from quick access to Edinburgh's thriving city centre, a range of outstanding schools, and excellent transport links including the city bypass and airport.
